Dear Friends and Colleagues!

It is a great honour to invite you to the 15th International Cave Bear Symposium in Slovakia and introduce to you a part of our beauty spot in the heartbeat of Europe. In year 2008, town Spišská Nová Ves celebrated 740 anniversary of the first writing reference concerning to the town.

We hope that our symposium will be not only as important meeting of experts on cave bears and fauna of Quaternary from the whole Europe, but also as important social and cultural event and happening. The entire Organization and Scientific Committee is cordially looking forward to you.

Location

The oldest historical documents of Spišská Nová Ves are from 1268, but the archaeological finds reveal that civilization in this region date to at least the 8th century. The town is located in the basin of the Hornád River. On the north, it is boarded by the Levočské vrchy Mts. and on the south the Spišsko-Gemerské rudohorie Mts. is situated. The town and its environs are very attractive by both the natural beauties and the cultural historical heritage. The town's mining tradition is related to the rich occurrence sites of iron, silver and copper ores and the right of their exploring. Ironworks of Konrad Gaal used to be the most famous one out of the handicrafts. In 18th century the city became residency of Province of 16 Spiš cities and remained till 1876. Not only the lentil shapes square in Spišská Nová Ves being the longest square of this type in Europe and Roman-Catholic church tower in Slovakia being 87 m tall, but also Provincial house, Reduta, building of City Hall and others count among the real historical jewels of the town. The town offers cultural and sports events during the whole year and it is real gate to the Slovak Paradise Mts

How to get there

Town Spišská Nová Ves is situated in the eastern part of Slovakia, on the main railway line Bratislava – Košice. The distance from capital city Bratislava is about 350 km. Close to Spišská Nová Ves, two airports are situated: Poprad – www.airportpoprad.sk (distance 30 km) and Košice – www.airportkosice.sk (distance 80 km). The main airport is situated in Bratislava – capital city of Slovakia. Possibilities of transport are by air – www.skyeurope.com, by train – www.skyeurope.com<

The Venue

The Conference will be held in Gallery of Artists of Spiš, street Zimná ulica Nr. 46, Spišská Nová Ves, which is situated in the centre of city square www.gus.sk. We believe that pleasant ambient of the Gallery, spacious conference rooms with capacity about 80 people, space, which is suitable for poster presentations and also with a place for coffee break, as well as small snacks, it will guarantee pleasant proceedings. Close the Gallery you can find many restaurants and coffee-rooms.

The building of host Museum of Spiš (Provincial house) is situated on the opposite street with distance from the Gallery about 150 m – named Letná ulica Nr. 50, www.muzeumspisa.com

From Railway station you can reach the centre close Gallery by local public transport or by taxi (5 minutes).

Climate and Clothing

Weather in the Spiš area during the September is usually more or less stable, especially in the second half of the month when the nature is slowly passing from Summer time to the time of Indian Summer. There is also a possibility of rain, but long-running and heavy rainfall is not expected. The temperature may range from $10\text{-}15\,^{\circ}\text{C}$ during the night to $\sim 20\,^{\circ}\text{C}$ and more during the day.

The cave clothing with a light is necessary for the visit of Medvedia jaskyňa (Bear Cave in the Slovensky raj Mts.)
